New! IGTM Regional Meetings

The aim of the International Society for the Study of Medieval Theology (IGTM) is to promote research and scholarly exchange in the field of medieval theology. The Society is international, interdenominational, and interdisciplinary. *Archa Verbi* is our annual journal, and conference proceedings, editions, and monographs are published in our *Archa Verbi Subsidia* series. All scholars who are interested in medieval theology are invited to become a member or seek cooperation with the IGTM.

The IGTM supports local and **Regional Meetings** for all those interested in medieval theology, whether (doctoral) students, junior scholars, or senior scholars. These can be Workshops, Reading Groups (e.g., for source reading under the guidance of an expert), or Exchange Forums for early career scholars. The goal is twofold: on the one hand, interested students and young scholars are brought together with established medievalists. At such (regular) meetings medieval sources, topics or research questions can be discussed. In this way, researchers can receive valuable feedback in informal settings and interest in research into medieval theology can be awakened and promoted. On the other hand, Regional Meetings also serve to connect members of the IGTM in a certain region with local Faculties and Institutions. Together with our Annual Conference, *Archa Verbi* yearbook and series, and Virtual Winter Lecture, these meetings will contribute to the relevance and vitality of our Society as well as the field of Medieval Theology as a whole.

A **first Regional Meeting** is now planned in the Netherlands: On 21 June 2023, a Workshop for PhD students and young scholars will take place in Utrecht on the topic: "Rules, Regulations, and Regimes in Medieval Religion." Workshop participants can also participate in the Third Annual *Franciscan Connections* Virtual Conference on "Rules, Regulations, and Regimes in Franciscan Spirituality" on 22 and 23 June 2023 (see: www.franciscanconnections.com).
